Environmental and Animal Extremist Groups *Their Missions and Methods*

This seminar will examine the wide variety of environmental and animal activist / extremist groups involved in criminal activity. Following an introduction to these groups, the focus will be on targets that can be found throughout Illinois, and how these types of targets have been, and may be, exploited in the future. Attendees will be able to recognize the locations, tattoos, logos and patterns of these groups.

“Lone Wolf” or leaderless resistance operations are becoming a choice to threat groups and they post their call to action on the internet and local social media outlets. Attendees will be provided with information on sites, tools and methods to follow and track incidents as they are being planned, or assist in the investigation after the incident has passed.

Some criminal-based groups have been using open internet sites as a tool to collect intelligence on scientists, corporate executives, and even law enforcement officers. Recent examples of law enforcement being targeted will be discussed. Techniques and tools to avoid being targeted by criminals will also be demonstrated.

Presenters:

Lisa Blimling is a Terrorism Research Specialist, with a concentration in animal rights and environmental extremists. Ms. Blimling has a Bachelors Degree in psychology and a Masters Degree in criminal justice. She has been with STIC since its inception in 2003.
