He is an expert on anti-money laundering and terrorist financing and previously worked with the Secret Service and the CIA.

Sheriff Jeff Sandy (Wood County, WV)

Prior to Mr. Sandy becoming the Sheriff of Wood County, West Virginia, he worked as a Supervisory Special Agent for the Department of the Treasury, IRS / CID. He has worked some of the largest national and international cases for the U.S. Government and was part of the Baghdad counterterrorism team that traced the hidden assets of Saddam Hussein and his regime.
